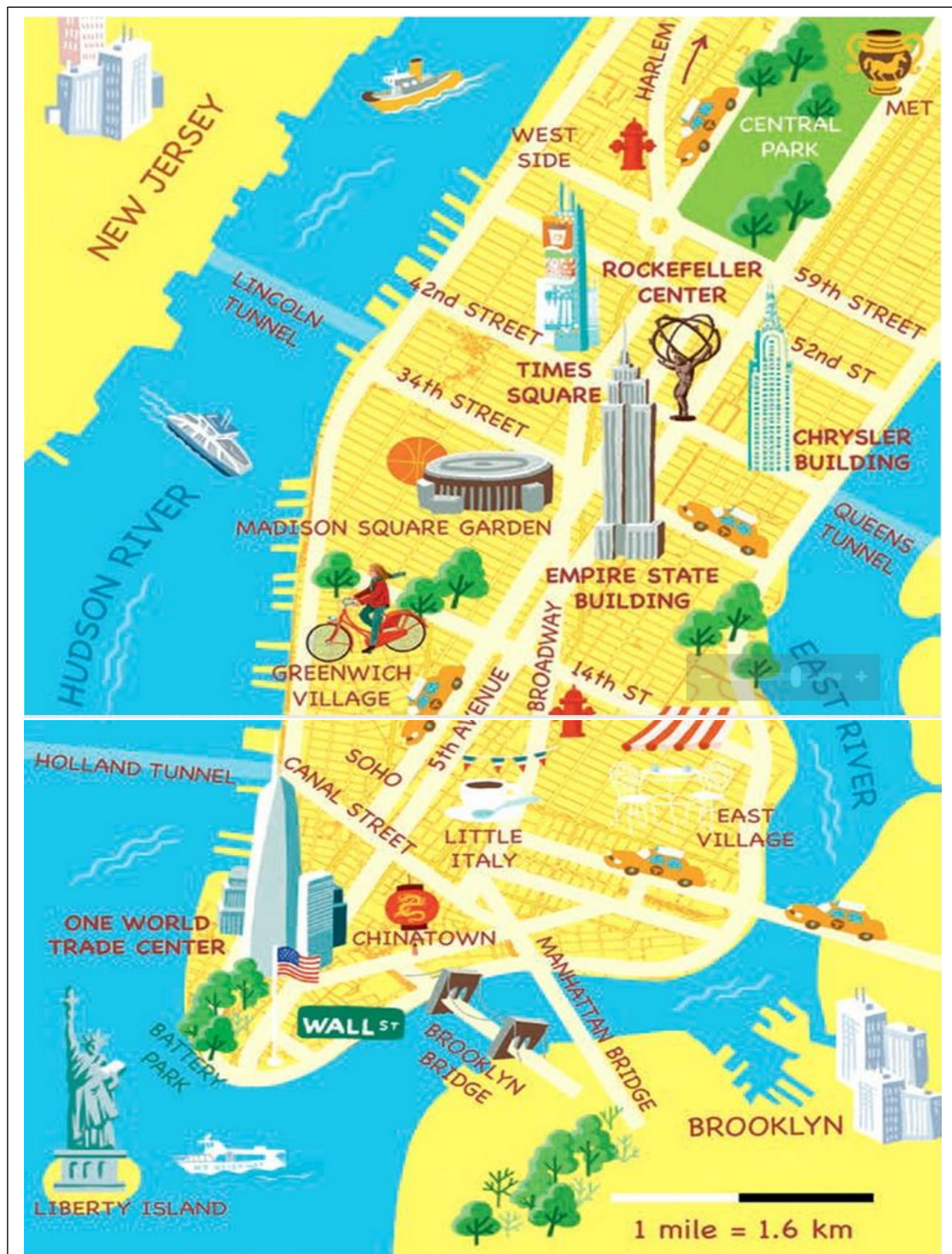
- ❖ The numbers of speakers: **4**

Manhattan forms a grid of 228 **streets** and 12 **avenues**. 2 avenues and 2 streets form a rectangle called a **block**.



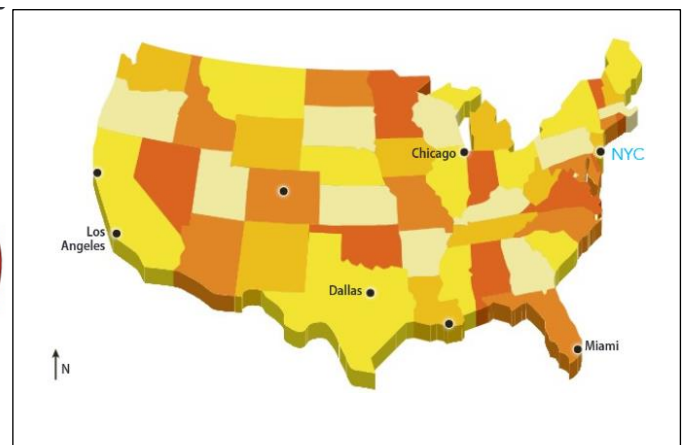

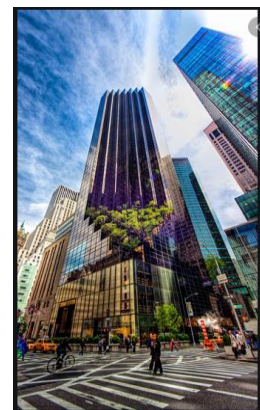
